## **JUDGMENT**

In the matter of Election into the office of Chairman of Abuja Municipal Area Council held on the 12<sup>th</sup> of February, 2022. The Appellant herein is appealing against the decision of the Area Council Election Tribunal, Abuja.

Being dissatisfied with the judgment of the Trial Tribunal, the Appellant appealed against same vide its Notice of Appeal filed on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

In the Notice of Appeal dated the 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 and filed same date, Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) as Appellant challenged the decision of the Lower Tribunal upturning the election and return of MurtalaUsmanwho was 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent.

Brief of argument dated the 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 was filed same date and same was served on the Respondents.

MurtalaUsman the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent filed his brief of argument and same was adopted by his counsel, SharafaYusuff, Esq.

All Progressives Congress (APC) the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent filed its brief of argument and same was adopted by its counsel, Hassan Liman, SAN.

Permit me to mention here that both counsel for the 4<sup>th</sup>Respondent Chief Karina Tunyan, SAN, andAminu Esq. conceded to the Appeal filed by Peoples Democratic Party (PDP). The reliefs sought by the Appellant are herein enumerated, as follows:-

- a. An Order allowing this appeal in its entirety.
- b. An Order setting aside the decision of the Area Council Election Tribunal nullifying the declaration and return of the Appellant and the 4<sup>th</sup> Respondent as the winners of the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2022 Abuja Municipal Area Council Chairmanship Election.
- c. An Order affirming and/or restoring the results and/or decision of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent which declared the Appellant and the 4<sup>th</sup> Respondent as the winners of the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2022 Abuja Municipal Area Council Chairmanship Election.

And for such further Order(s) as this Honoruable Appeal Tribunal may deem fit to make in the circumstance of this appeal.

Appellant filed reply briefs to the respective Respondents' briefs. Filed on the 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 and 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 respectively.

KehindeOgunwumiju, SAN, for the Appellant (PDP) formulated two issues for determination, to wit;

1. Whether the trial Tribunal was right when it accorded probative value to the election results tendered by the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondents and proceeded to prefer them to the election results tendered by the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Respondents which established that

the Appellant and the 4<sup>th</sup> Respondent won the Election in issue? (Distilled from grounds 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26 of the Notice of Appeal filed on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.)

2. Whether the Trial Tribunal was right when it found that the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondents proved their petition and proceeded to grant the reliefs sought by them? (Distilled from ground 1, 2, 4, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 of the Notice of Appeal filed on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

On the part of 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent, counsel formulated two issues for determination in his brief of argument, to - wit;

- Whether the Trial Tribunal was right when a. it placed more value on certified true copies of Form EC8As tendered by the 1st and 2nd Respondents which were certified 5 days after the election and Forms EC8As tendered by Nigerian Police, Nigerian Security and Civil Defense, All Progressives Grant Alliance and Peoples Redemption Party as against certified true copies of the documents tendered by the same Respondent certified 3 months and 11 days after election. (Grounds 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26).
- b. Whether the Trial Tribunal was right when it held that 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondents proved their joint Petition on preponderance of

# Evidence and declared the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent winner of the election. (Grounds 1, 2, 4, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18).

2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent on their part, filed Respondent's brief of argument dated the 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 and filed same date. Wherein two (2) issues were formulated by 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent for determination in their brief of argument, as follows:-

a. Whether the Trial Tribunal was not right when it accorded probative value to the Election Results tendered by the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondents and proceed to prefer them to the Election Results tendered by the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Respondents (Grounds 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26 of the Notice of Appeal)

b. Whether the Trial Tribunal was not right when it found that the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondents proved their Petition and proceeded to grant the Reliefs sought in the Petition. (Grounds 1, 2, 4, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18) of the Notice of Appeal.

You will recall that during the hearing of the appeal, counsel had agreed that same be consolidated with the other appeals touching on the election of Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC) Chairmanship held on the 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.

Without delving into the issues raised by counsel for the respective parties in this appeal, having allowed the appeal in No. FCT/ACEAT/AP/01/2022, and set aside the

judgment of the lower Tribunal which was the basis of this appeal, it suffices therefore to hold that instant appeal has considered merit and accordingly hereby succeeds. Thefurther determination of the issues in this appeal which have been determined under the lone issue in the considered appeal No. 01/22 becomes unnecessary.

Consequently, the instant appeal No. FCT/ACEAT/AP/08/2022 will abide by the decision of this Court in Appeal No.FCT/ACEAT/AP/01/2022.
